Elementary School Choirs: Sight-Reading (Rhythm only)

The following must be read aloud to the ensemble by the compliance official prior to the instruction period while the director is previewing the sight-reading exercise.

(Maximum of three minutes.)

Do not look at your sight-reading selection until your director instructs you to do so.

- Students, you and your director will have eight minutes to prepare the sight-reading exercise.
- Your director may not clap or chant the rhythm with you. Also, your director may not demonstrate note or rest values for you at any time during the sight-reading event.
- Students, you may count aloud, chant, or clap the rhythm individually, in small groups, or with your full ensemble at your director's discretion. Rests in the music must be silent during your performance.
- Your eight minutes will begin when your director asks you to look at your selection. Good luck!
