<b>Concert Attire</b>	Men - suit, tie, and dress shoes; OR, sports coat, dress slacks, and dress shoes; Ladies - nice pants suit, nice dress, or nice top and bottom with dress shoes; <b>Please look professional!</b>					
<b>Hotel Reservation #</b>	<b>DOUBLE CHECK YOUR HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS</b> (You will need to let us know where you are staying and the name of your responsible chaperone.)					
<b>CELL NUMBER:</b>	You will have to provide us with your cell phone number IN CASE we need to reach you for being late or tardy to rehearsal, etc. Let's hope this doesn't happen.					
<b>PRACTICE YOUR MUSIC...</b>	<b>BE PREPARED TO PERFORM, NOT TO LEARN PARTS AT THE REHEARSALS.</b> Please be as prepared as you possibly can. This is going to be an awesome experience!!!					
<b>Be On Time!</b>	"TO BE EARLY IS TO BE ON TIME; TO BE ON TIME IS TO BE LATE." This means be early to each rehearsal. 10 – 15 minutes is sufficient for warm-up and getting to your position. Please don't walk in 5 minutes before the scheduled rehearsal time and then rush yourself to get ready.
