FINAL CHECKLIST (WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU...)

Stands/Pencils!	You must bring a music stand. There will be none available. You must also have a pencil with you for every rehearsal.

Concert Attire	Orchestra attire is Solid Black! Ladies if you wear a dress make sure the length is at least 2 inches below the knees. Gentleman if you wear a white shirt with a black tie or bow tie you must have a black coat, black socks and black shoes. Jeans, Tennis Shoes/Sneakers will not be allowed. (NO EXCEPTIONS!) Please look professional!
Hotel Reservation #	DOUBLE CHECK YOUR HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS (You will need to let us know where you are staying and the name of your responsible chaperone.)
CELL NUMBER:	You will have to provide us with your cell phone number IN CASE we need to reach you for being late or tardy to rehearsal, etc. Let's hope this doesn't happen.
PRACTICE YOUR MUSIC...	BE PREPARED TO PERFORM, NOT TO LEARN PARTS AT THE REHEARSALS. Please be as prepared as you possibly can. Make sure you go over your parts with your Orchestra or Band Director, Talent teacher or private Teacher. Some transposition might be required (ex. Trombone part written in tenor cleff) This is going to be an awesome experience!!!
Be On Time!	"TO BE EARLY IS TO BE ON TIME; TO BE ON TIME IS TO BE LATE." This means be early to each rehearsal. 10 – 15 minutes is sufficient for warm-up and getting to your position. Please don't walk in 5 minutes before the scheduled rehearsal time and then rush yourself to get ready.
